ANATOMY OF VERDEJO

The **Singular Vineyards of La Seca Catalogue** is a project promoted by the La Seca Town Council in response to the local community's desire to express its regional identity within **D.O. Rueda**. The presence of the **River Douro**, which gently borders the municipality of **La Seca**, provides geomorphological characteristics that shape its landscape, distinguished by its vineyards.

Both the identity and image of La Seca are expressed by the label **'Cradle of Verdejo'**, and its leadership is based on objective facts, being the **municipality with the most vineyard surface area in Castilla y León** and home to more than 20 wineries.

This catalogue, along with the municipal underground wine cellar (from the 18th century), is a **unique and differentiating testimony to its culture and people**.

Built between 1791 and 1795, designed by architect Ventura Rodríguez (1717-1785). Herrerian-style interior patio.



SINGULAR VINEYARDS
10 vineyard areas classified as unique by the local community and research group for the promotion of the municipality's wine and landscape heritage.



REPLICA OF THE TOWER AT THE CHURCH OF NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA ASUNCIÓN
Made by La Seca resident Gregorio P. Méndez in March 2015 as a tribute to the missing original body of the tower at the Church of Nuestra Señora de la Asunción (January 1962).

18th century baroque shrine



MUNICIPAL UNDERGROUND WINE CELLAR
Located under the 'Buenos Aires' dance floor. Model of a local historic winery from the 18th century: Winery and Residence.



VENERABLE THIRD ORDER OF SAINT FRANCIS
18th century chapel. Deconsecrated. Restoration carried out by Javier Sanz Viticultor (2018).



MURAL TRIBUTE TO JUAN MACÍAS REVUELTA

LA CILLA CULTURAL SPACE
Historic building from 1797, old royal granary.



BAROQUE ORGAN
1790-1792, Antonio Ruiz. The non-cathedral organ with the greatest sound and artistic splendour in the region. Currently in use.



CHURCH OF NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LA ASUNCIÓN
Built in 1548 by R. Gil de Hontañón on top of the ruins of the original church in honour of Saint Mary of the Assumption.
